> The distribution of marks for continuous assessment will be as follows for Generic Elective subjects:

- a) For papers with 5+1 credit system: the continuous assessment will be on 20% of the total marks allocated in the paper as per syllabus and subsequent modifications. The mode of the test remains open for the Instructor to decide.
- b) For papers with 4+2 credit system: the continuous assessment will be on 15% of the total marks allocated in the paper.

Therefore, for **Science** subjects, the marks allotted (15 marks) for the continuous evaluation of the practical / lab work may be treated as continuous assessment, as per the advice of the Dean of Sciences, thereby not opting to take a test for such papers for continuous assessment.

Respective course instructors will send the questions papers to the students via email or Google classroom or such other platform. For further queries, the students may contact the respective course instructor.

Note: The students having a backlog in GE courses do NOT need to appear for mid semester examination/ continuous Assessment.

However, those having a backlog in AECC courses will have to appear for mid semester examination/continuous Assessment.
